

## **EPA RRP OPT OUT AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the volunteer services which are being provided, I further acknowledge and agree that Rebuilding Together Aurora (the firm performing the renovation), as well as all volunteers and affiliated organizations and sponsors, will not be required to use the lead-safe work practices required by EPA's Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule. I confirm that I own and live in this property, that no child under the age of 6 resides here, that no pregnant woman resides here, and that this property is not a child-occupied facility.

**\*\*Note:** A child-occupied facility is a pre-1978 building visited regularly by the same child, under 6 years of age, on at least two different days within any week, for at least 3 hours each day, provided that the visits total at least 60 hours annually.
